A timebank matches your skills and talents with needs in the community.

Through a timebank we:

- get to know our neighbors
- support and care for one another
- build a sense of community
- affirm one another's contributions
- increase personal savings and wealth
- promote equality and social justice

A timebank helps us work together for the common good.

What Is a Timebank?

A timebank is a system that helps people share services with one another. As a member you earn a time dollar by doing a service for someone else. The time dollar you earn is "stored" in the timebank. You can spend time dollars by asking another member to do something for you. Look inside to see some examples of how it might work.

Joining the timebank is FREE. The only requirement is a willingness to participate.

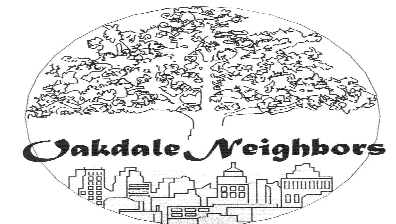

How Does the Timebank Work?



Jovan cleans Jose's carpeting. Alicia spends a time dollar by asking Jose to help her move some boxes.



Alicia earns a time dollar by working in Mary's garden.



Mary helps Tim care for his father. Tim drives Tanya to the store.



Tanya earns a time dollar by repairing Jovan's roof.



It's about Time!

A time dollar is a new kind of money based on time. You earn one time dollar for each hour that you spend providing a service for another member. Your time dollars are recorded in the timebank.

Who can earn time dollars? Anyone is welcomed to join the timebank and earn time dollars: those who are working, unemployed, disabled, elderly, teenagers, single parents, business people.... Age, income, and mobility are not barriers to joining the timebank. We all have something to offer.

What can I do with my time dollars? You spend your time dollars by asking other members for help: a ride to the store, childcare, basic home repair, or other services.

How much time is required of me? You can participate as much as you are able. Some members are busy people who help others as they go about their regular routines.
